


Rising discontent among doctors signals dire need for change

European doctors are unhappy with their workplace




Many doctors would not recommend their hospital to patients

The percentage of doctors unwilling to recommend their hospital to family or friends remains high in the UK and Italy and rose in Germany.




Workplace satisfaction also reflects a wide gender gap
